**THE COMMUNITY AWARD**

Glasgow West Housing Association (GWHA) is a charitable organisation with a key role in the Anderston, Burnbank, Hillhead, Hyndland and Kelvingrove areas of Glasgow. The Association was founded in 1978 and continues to be run by a Management Committee made of volunteers who have dedicated thousands of hours of their time on behalf of GW residents, to make the organisation a success in the community.

The person does not need to live in a GW property in order to be nominated.

Nominations for the Award are welcomed throughout the year, with the first presentation made at the Annual General Meeting in June 2009 and annually thereafter.

Reflecting his dedication to GWHA as well as his contribution to the wider community, this award will be known as the Jim Michael Community Award.
